## Is your collection missing the first-ever watermarked U.S. stamps?

*The first watermarked stamps were released in April 1895. The Bureau of Engraving and Printing (BEP) took over postage stamps from the American Bank Note Company in 1894. The BEP took the original dies and plates of the 1894 series and made some improvements. Watermarks were added to prevent counterfeiting, along with triangles in the corners to distinguish them from the 1890 stamp. These new stamps were the # 264-275, with Double Line watermark*
